ABSALON ***

15, Helgolandstgade, 1653 Copenhagen

The Absalon is a tourist class hotel, centrally located just a few hundred metres from the train station and Tivoli Gardens, attractions, shopping and restaurants. The rooms have a small fridge, while breakfast is self-service buffet style - restaurant and lobby refurbished in 2004. Save yourself a trip out to the harbour to see the Little Mermaid – a small, original sculpture of the same is waiting to greet you in reception!





HOTEL OPERA ★★★

Tordenskjoldsgade 15, Copenhagen 1055

This hotel is set just a couple of minutes walk from the top of the famous Stroget pedestrian street (a shopper's paradise) and the bustling bar and café life of the Nyhavn Canal area. The style of the hotel is that of a gentleman's club, with woodpaneled walls and dark red carpet.





IMPERIAL HOTEL ***

Vester Farimagsgade 9, Copenhagen 1606

The Imperial is centrally located, just a couple of minutes from Tivoli and a couple more from the main square and shopping area. The atmosphere is warm and relaxed and the style of the hotel is open, bright and airy. The brasserie bar area is large and inviting while the indoor Garden restaurant is an interesting feature in itself.





COPENHAGEN ADMIRAL HOTEL ***

24-28 Tolbodgade, Copenhagen 1253

This classy, stylish building overlooks the city's harbour and is located very close to the bustling bar and café area called Nyhavn and the royal Amalienbourg Palace. The hotel itself is a gigantic converted granary warehouse and features rough brick walls, huge 200-year wood beams and large archways, while there is a maritime theme running throughout the place. The rooms are finished to a very high standard in a Scandinavian style and the SALT bar and restaurant was designed by Conran and Partners.



STOCKHOLM

Located on the southeast coast of Sweden on the Baltic Sea, Stockholm is built on 14 islands. The old city (Galma Stan) is now a fascinating melee of Renaissance buildings interspersed with medieval alleys, with shops and restaurants squeezed into the atmospheric passageways. The modern centre of the city has wide streets, shops, office blocks and parks, making Stockholm one of Europe's cleanest and most attractive cities. Flights to Stockholm operate on regular basis with SAS.
